

How to Use Your Sewing Machine Test Questions

1. What happens if you don't lower the presser foot before starting to sew?
 - a. Nothing
 - b. Your fabric doesn't move and no stitches are formed
2. How carefully should you lower the presser foot?
 - a. Doesn't matter
 - b. Gently to avoid damage to the machine
3. What should you do when you come to a pin in the fabric while you're sewing a seam?
 - a. Sew over the pin and keep on sewing
 - b. Remove each pin when you get to it
4. Are you supposed to sew really fast or take your time to do a good job?
 - a. Sew really fast
 - b. Sew slowly and carefully
5. What does it mean to "complete the stitch" when you stop sewing?
 - a. The take-up lever is in its highest position
 - b. You do some backstitching
6. When you're in the middle of a seam and you need to stop to make an adjustment, where should you have the needle when you stop for that adjustment?
 - a. In the up position above the fabric
 - b. In the down position in the fabric
 - c. Doesn't matter
7. You can always use the hand wheel to take a single stitch or just to position the needle. Which direction do you "ONLY" turn the hand wheel.

8. What happens when you don't disengage the hand wheel of your sewing machine before you wind your bobbin?
